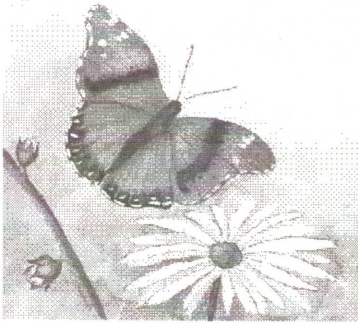
## Addition to Babysitting and Pet Care List
