



## Recipe of the Month

### Valentine Cutouts

In a bowl, dissolve 2 packages red jello in 2-1/2 cups of boiling water; set aside for 30 minutes.

In a small bowl, whisk 1 cup cold milk and 1 pack instant vanilla pudding mix until smooth, about 1 minute. Quickly pour into jello; whisk until well blended. Pour into an oiled 13x9x2" dish. Chill until set. Cut into cubes or use a heart-shaped cookie cutter.
