Annual Drinking Water Quality Report

Well Water Pump Replacement

In July we are planning on replacing the well water pump and piping from the pump to the water system connection. We will also do maintenance on electrical equipment at the well head and perform water flow and draw down tests. The well pump is at least 20 years old and the piping may be as old as the system itself (40+ years). Residents will be notified by email when we have more information about when the work will take place and any impacts on water service. We will also place signs at both entrances to the subdivision if there is an interruption in service and/or a boil order is necessary. This work has been part of our long-term plans to perform additional necessary maintenance on our water system once the chemical building and water tower refurbishing projects were completed. Completion of this project including the water source testing will provide information which will help us determine when a backup well will need to be developed.

Water Hydrant Flushing Schedule - 2024

The six water hydrants located in Indian Creek subdivision will be flushed on the dates listed below. Water hydrants are flushed in order to reduce the build-up of sediments in our water system. This is an important process for improving water quality. Our water operator will flush one hydrant at a time and allow it to run for 10-15 minutes (the next in line hydrant is opened concurrently for a brief period to keep water flowing through the system). Water pressure in our system's lines is maintained by the 35,000 gallons of water in our tower, however, pressure in home lines will be reduced during flushing much like when multiple faucets are opened in your homes. Flushing the hydrants will also stir up sediments so please follow the procedures listed below:

- Do not run water during the flushing time period.
- Following flushing, run water through faucets until clear. We recommend this be done by-passing
 any treatment/filtering system in your home because of the increased sediment stirred up during the
 flushing process.

Please mark your calendars with the dates listed below. Flushing will be done between 5:30 a.m. and 6:30 a.m. weather permitting. **Hydrants will not be flushed in freezing conditions or other inclement weather.**

Summer Lawn Watering

Please follow our recommended summer watering schedule by only watering on even or odd days corresponding to your street address number and limit watering to 3-4 hours. This will help ensure our well pump can replace water being used in our tower. Summer water usage typically is much higher than the rest of the year and can strain our water system capabilities.

Indian Creek Subdivision Water System Maps/Technical Drawings

The maps show the location of each lot's water shutoff valve (also known as curb stops) indicated by an "S" with measurements from the lot boundary lines and the main water line. It is important residents know where their shutoff valve is located in case water to a residence needs to be turned off due to maintenance or a water line break between the shutoff and residences' inside shutoff valve. Some water shutoffs have been buried during home construction or landscaping. A picture of a shutoff valve is shown below.
