Help coordinate the periodic Audubon Society Bird Count by being a contact person for the organization and reporting results back to our residents.

## Indian Creek Website

Assist with maintaining the Indian Creek website or providing and updating website content.

## Roadside Clean-Up

Participate in the periodic roadside clean-up of County Road 29 that runs along the Indian Creek neighborhood.

## Little Free Library

Donate books or assist with book rotation for the Little Free Library located near the neighborhood bridge.
